Helping the 'Poor'

Matthew 25:40 "And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me."

The Bible teaches us to help the poor, to pray for them, to look after them. But who are these 'poor' people? Are they the beggars, the homeless, the squatters? Yes, in the world all these people exist too, and Jesus by example helped them as much as He could.

But the real poor are the Servants of God. Matthew 5:3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

That is why Jesus refers to the deeds done to the poor people.
