Is there any point in getting married? Matthew 19:11 & 12 *But he said unto them, All men cannot receive this saying, save they to whom it is given. For there are some eunuchs, which were so born from their mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, which were made eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He that is able to receive it, let him receive it.*

Luke 20:34 & 35 *And Jesus answering said unto them, The children of this world marry, and are given in marriage: But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage:*

If there is no married life between people in Eternity, then is there even a reason to get married on earth? It doesn't really prepare us for life in eternity; it only sanctifies us, teaching us to be long suffering, patient, selfless, charitable, etc. Jesus even went to the extent of saying that the children of the world only marry.
