SIXTH

Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever. And presently the fig tree withered away. - Matthew 21:19

Was Jesus angry when He cursed the fig tree? When we are hungry, we often get annoyed, angry or irritated easily before being able to eat something.

> In the case of the tree, it may have not been able to control when it should have brought forth fruit; but we need to be able to bring forth fruit when we come to spiritual maturity.

> We may have been faithfully going to church, faithfully doing our ministries; but are we still found as 'babes in Christ'? Are we able to take correction in the right way? When we should be teaching others about Christ, are we still longing for others to teach us?

> When we should be ministering to others about the love of Christ, are we grumbling and murmuring that the ministers don't visit us?

> One day, the Angels will ask us to tell them about the love of Christ, and to teach them the mysteries that have been revealed to us.
