

Tenth Mystery: The Battle for Jerusalem & hatred of the Jews:

Psalm 122:6 *Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.*

Everyone wants to be in the 'centre' of the world; maybe it is because this is what God wanted as His habitation. But He also wanted His chosen people, the Jews to occupy it and the area around Jerusalem. The hatred for Jews stems from this; because God chose them, and no other nation. But you cannot be in Jerusalem without recognising that the Jews are God's chosen people. Many have realised that when we recognise this, and recognise Jerusalem as the earthly city of God, and His chosen, then prosperity comes. There is a blessing for those who recognise this.

Those who continue to hate the Jews will not prosper; how can you defeat God's people? Even if they do not defend themselves or fight for themselves, then God will defend them, He will fight for them. Unfortunately, people have not realised this, and they continue to try and destroy the Jews. They cannot and will not be destroyed; the Word of God prophesies this. From the time they became a nation, that is, from the time God recognised them as His people (in the land Goshen in Egypt), other nations have been trying to destroy them (Egyptians, Assyrians, Babylonians, Medo-Persians, Romans, Grecians, the Crusades, Nazi-Germany, and finally Anti-Christ).

The Word of God says that Anti-Christ will try again to destroy the Jews; it will happen to the extent that it will be much worse than the Holocaust. In fact, only 144,000 Jews will be left on the planet, twelve thousand from each tribe (Revelation 7) How they are numbered according to their tribes we do not know; only God has said that He will preserve this many Jews from the destruction of the Anti- Christ.
