

Chapter 5 – Appointments with the Lord

Genesis 3:8 *And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.* God visited Adam in the cool of the day. This appointment may continue in the Millennial Reign also where Jesus will come and meet with each one of us in the cool of the day, evening time, when the sun is going down. It may be gathering or a service, or it may be a personal visit. Whatever the type of meeting, we will be longing to see Jesus and speak to Him. Right now, we are longing to see Jesus when the Rapture takes place; the Jews are longing for their Messiah. But will be still be longing to see Jesus once we are united with Him.

Even more, will we be longing to meet and report to the Lord everything we have done that day. In this life, whether we are married or unmarried, to be long to come home and tell someone about our day and everything that happened to us? We may long to share such things with our spouses, or a friend. But how many of us long to share such things with Jesus in prayer? Do we long for those prayer times when it is just Jesus and us, talking to each other in the closet? That should be the nature of our prayer life, because that will be daily life in the Millennial Reign, except we are speaking to the Lord face to face. This was the practice of the disciples, when they were commanded to go into the villages and preach.

Mark 6:30 *And the apostles gathered themselves together unto Jesus, and told him all things, both what they had done, and what they had taught.*

In that time, we will not keep the Lord waiting, but we will be ready to receive Him into our house. He wants to be involved in our lives and know what we are doing. Such will be daily life there, where the Lord visits us every day.

Isaiah 65:24 *And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear.*

It may be that we need to ask the Lord something, to check some detail, or share something with Him. It may be possible in that time of Millennial Reign to instantly get a response from the Lord. We do this now when we are in trouble, or we need the Lord. Even while we are calling, Jesus will appear instantly to answer us. We know that in His resurrected body, Jesus was able to move through doors and buildings, even from place to place. This is how our bodies will be during this time.

Luke 24:15 *And it came to pass, that, while they communed together and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.*

John 20:19 *Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you.*

John 20:26 *And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you.*

John 21:4 *But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus.*

Instant Transportation:

Acts 8:39,40 *And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing. But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea.*

We get a glimpse of how transport and travel will be during the Millennial Reign when we read about Philip. He was already experiencing this mode of instant transport while he was doing his ministry. Not only will we have a resurrected body to go through doors, walls, and from place to place; but we will be able to go instantly between towns, countries, continents, etc. This is the only way we can do our ministry in that time, and be found in Jerusalem on the Sabbath.
